Marieann Laurin has been a standout competitor and respected member of the MTCUSBC for over 20 years. Inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2016, Marieann's impressive accomplishments on the lanes reflect her skill, consistency, and dedication to the sport.

She has recorded six 300 games, numerous 11-in-a-row performances, and holds a high series of 751. Her top season averages include a 202 average in 2006-07, an impressive 216 in 2014-15, and a strong 211 in 2015-16. Over the years, she maintained a 200+ average for nine seasons, a testament to her long-term excellence.

Marieann's tournament record includes a **2nd place finish in both scratch and all events at the 2008 City Tournament**, followed by a dominant performance in **2009**, where she claimed **1st place in singles, doubles, and all events**. She repeated her success in **2016**, again winning **1st in singles and all events at the city level**, and added a **state doubles title** to her achievements the same year.

Marieann's consistent performance and championship pedigree make her a celebrated member of the MTCUSBC Hall of Fame.
